- ► What is Labour Market Information-LMI?
- ▶ LMI outlines the current trends in the job/labour market (including the skills needed for future jobs, and jobs most likely to be needed in the future)
- This information constantly changes-so it's recommended that research happens at each major transition stage e.g. before Post 16 & Post 19 choices are made, any career transition point

What is LMI continued

- Jobs and skills trends information can be found at a local level (Dorset) and beyond e.g. Nationally and Internationally
- The information can be used to help people make good decisions about their career journeys, as well as supporting education/training choices
